40 Years of Caring

Learning one's child has cancer is one of the most heartbreaking moments that a parent could possibly face. Outliving a son or daughter is a devastating thought no one would ever want to endure. The AROCC story is about a very small group of parents who came together sharing a common but tragic bond . . . each had a child diagnosed with cancer. Their involvement extended through the many months of treatment for their child and subsequently for some, the tragic loss of their child. These same parents looked beyond their own grieving process and worked together to start the formation of a neophyte cancer organization. In 1971, the Association for Research of Childhood Cancer (AROCC) officially formed as a not-for-profit corporation. From very humble roots using a bus called "AROCC Moves a Mountain" to sell arts and crafts, AROCC after 40 years of fundraising is proud to say close to 3 million dollars has been raised exclusively for researching



breakthroughs in childhood cancer treatment and cure. A number of the "founders" continue to

serve on the Board. And it is no wonder that this devotion has now trickled down to our youngest group of supporters, "Kids helping Kids", who do their own independent fundraising for AROCC. A lemonade stand last year which raised \$250 for AROCC, this

year the Windermere Elementary School team of Maya Shrikant, Claire Wanzer, Molly Nelson, Felicia Ponikau, Mary Clare Kuhn, Elizabeth Thompson and Liza Florczak presented AROCC with a check for \$700 and a letter stating "We also sold bracelets (made by us) and cookies (made by our parents). Raising money for your program makes us happy to know that somebody somewhere was using it in a good way to try to figure out a cure for childhood cancer."

And yes, they will be back this summer.

The caring, that began so many years ago with strong community support here in Western New York, continues everyday with supporters now from all over the country, as well as, beyond. Thank you to the Moll, Halicki, Winkle, Vosburgh, Hayes, Tabone, Penny, Dudas, Moody families and Dr. Lucius Sinks for caring. They began the long journey with such compassion and the AROCC story will end only when childhood cancer is eliminated.


